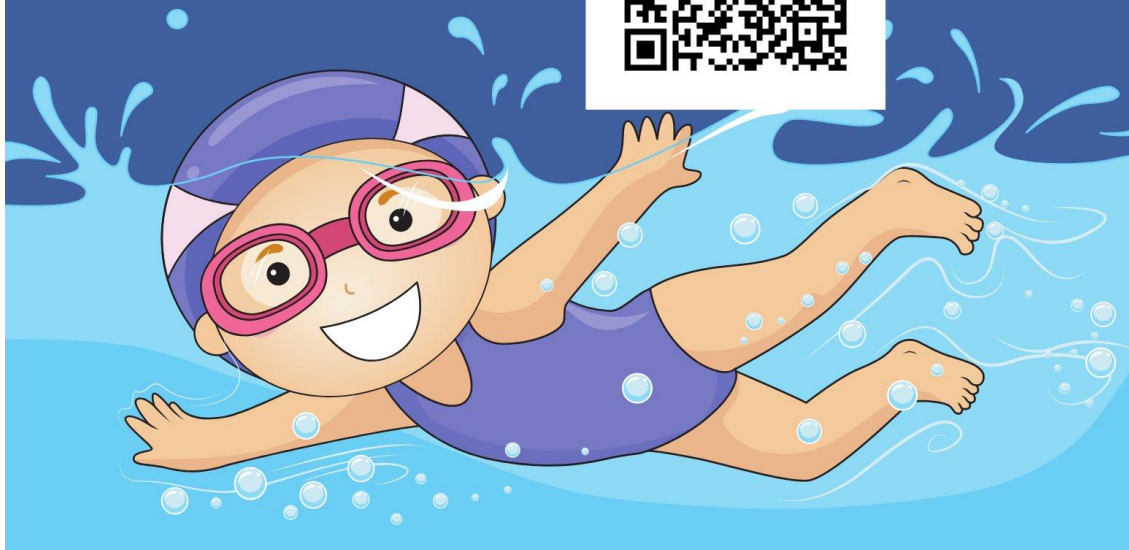

## *Help Us Plan a Better Park!*

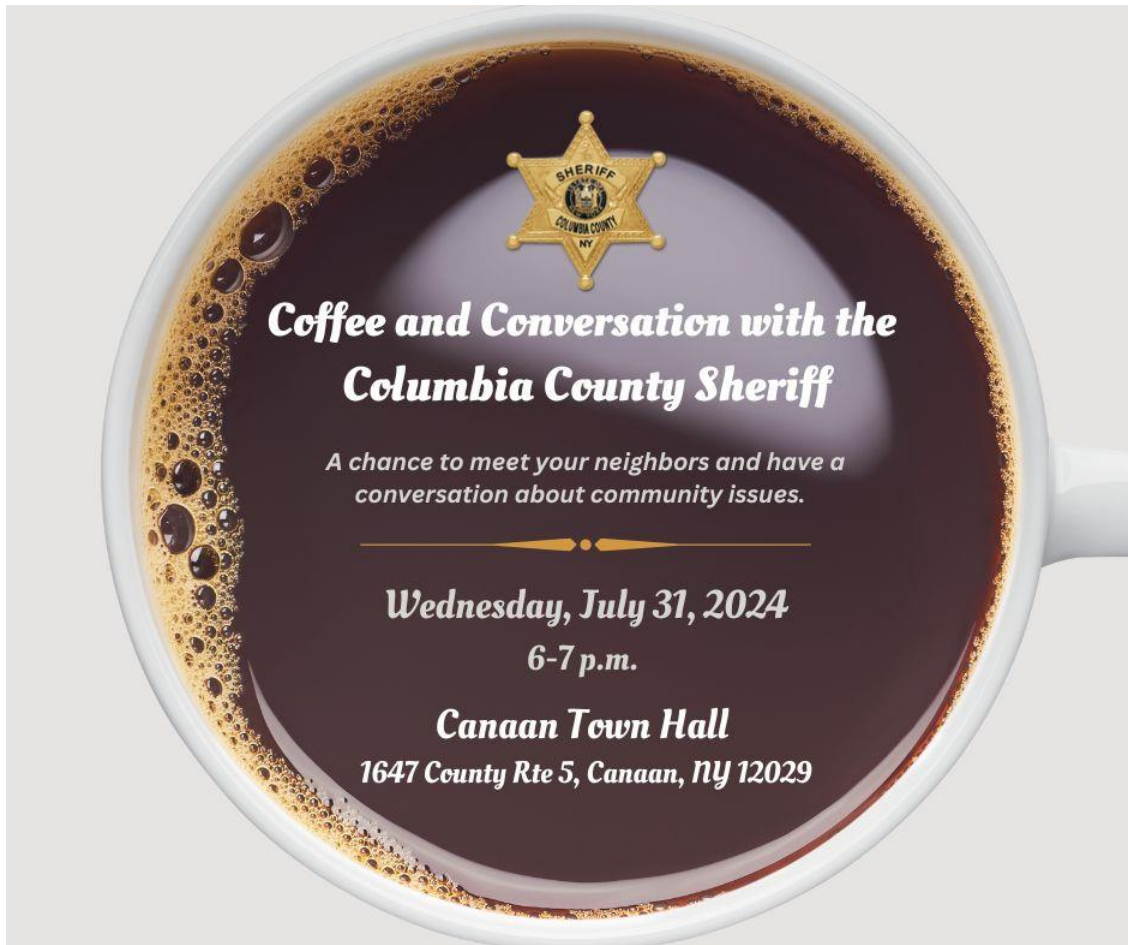
