

NYSVTL – New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law

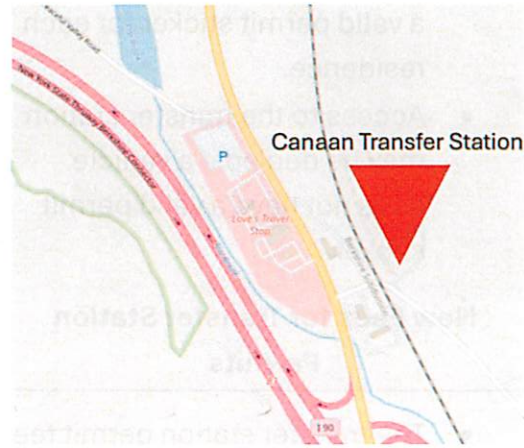
§380-a. Certain vehicles engaged in the transportation of loose cargo.

1. It shall be unlawful to operate on any public highway any open truck or trailer being utilized for the transportation of any loose substances, unless said truck or trailer has a cover, tarpaulin or other device of a type and specification approved by the commissioner of transportation which completely closes in the opening on the said truck or trailer while said truck or trailer shall be so operated, so as to prevent the falling of any such substances therefrom. However, if the load is arranged so that no loose substance can fall from or blow out of such truck, the covering is not necessary.

2. The commissioner of transportation is authorized to make necessary rules and regulations to carry into effect the provisions of this section, applying such provisions to specific conditions and loads and prescribing means, methods and practices to effectuate such provisions.

3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers conveying "farm products" as defined in section two of the agriculture and markets law.

Town of Canaan Transfer Station Permit Guide

Transfer Station Permit Rules for Residents

- Permits are only available to town residents. Applicants for a transfer station permit must provide proof of residency, such as a recorded deed, utility bill, tax bill, or other bill in the applicant's name at a property address located within the Town of Canaan.
- Applicants must also provide their license plate number, which will be written on the permit sticker.
- Stickers are non-transferable, they're intended for use by a single home or business.
- Residents may request another sticker for their second vehicle, providing the vehicle and its driver both also reside at the same address.
- Multi-use applicants like property managers, homeowner associations, contractors, etc. must acquire

a valid permit sticker for each residence.

- Access to the transfer station may be denied if a vehicle does not have a valid permit sticker.

New Fees for Transfer Station Permits

- The transfer station permit fee is \$25.
- With the additional purchase of a county recycling permit, the transfer station permit fee is reduced to \$20.
- Permits for 2025 are valid from the date of purchase through December 31st, 2025.
- Permit fees apply to a full or partial year.

Rules for MSW – Municipal Solid Waste

- All MSW must arrive in a vehicle with a valid sticker.
- In accordance with NYS Traffic Laws (see reverse side), all waste must be enclosed or

tarped. Otherwise, the load will be rejected.

- All MSW must be bagged.
- Each resident is allowed two contractor bags (maximum 56 gallons each) per delivery day.

Rules for Residential C&D – Construction and Demolition Waste

- With the purchase of a transfer station permit, each residence and business in the Town of Canaan is allowed two **single-ton** C&D permits per year. Residents and businesses are responsible for any C&D material weighing in excess of their annual two-ton limit.
- All residential C&D traffic must present town permits while on the scale. After dumping, remember to circle around in order to weigh out.
- Residential C&D permits may only be used Saturdays 8:00AM – 11:45 AM
