RESOLUTION 82-2026 to adopt a Heat Emergency Plan

At a regular meeting of the Canaan Town Board, held at the Canaan Town Hall, 1647 County Route 5, Canaan, New York, duly called and held on the 11th day of May 2026, the following Resolution was proposed and seconded.

WHEREAS, extremely hot days are happening more frequently and pose risks to people’s health, especially households without access to air conditioning, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Canaan has established coordinated procedures to prepare for, respond to, and recover from extreme heat events, supplementing the town’s Emergency Preparedness Plan, and

WHEREAS, a Heat Emergency Plan operates under the authority of New York State Executive Law Article 2-B, and aligns with New York State Climate Smart Communities adaptation and resilience objectives,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Canaan adopts a Heat Emergency Plan to protect residents during extreme heat events.
