RESOLUTION 104-2026 to approve an agreement with Adams Point Beach Association for purchase of swim passes

At a regular meeting of the Canaan Town Board, held at the Canaan Town Hall, 1647 County Route 5, Canaan, New York, duly called and held on the 13th day of July 2026, the following Resolution was proposed and seconded.

WHEREAS, there is a safety issue associated with residents and non-residents using the DEC boat launch for unmonitored swimming,

WHEREAS, the town has limited options to address the safety issue as it is not a party to the contract between the owner of the property and DEC, and it has no standing to monitor swimming at the site,

WHEREAS, the town would like to provide additional swimming access to town residents via free town passes to Adams Point Beach, for the ten weeks beginning June 28 and including July 05, July 12, July 19, July 26, August 02, August 9, August 16, August 23, August 30, at a cost not to exceed \$2700,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board authorizes the Town Supervisor to execute a 2026 agreement with Adams point Beach Association for same purpose,
