

TOWN OF CANAAN – August 10th, 2026

RESOLUTION 109-2026 Request to Reduce Speed Limit on SR 22 in the area of the B3 exit of I-90, Flint’s Crossing Road, and Peaceful Valley Road

At a regular meeting of the Canaan Town Board, held at the Canaan Town Hall, 1647 County Route 5, Canaan, New York, duly called and held on the 10th day of August 2026, the following Resolution was proposed and seconded.

WHEREAS, the Town of Canaan and emergency agencies have repeatedly expressed concerns over several years, about unsafe speeds, limited sightlines, and the volume of truck and residential traffic on SR 22 **around the B3 exit of I-90**, Flint’s Crossing Road and Peaceful Valley Road;

WHEREAS, the speed limit of 55 MPH in this area is no longer safe given the proliferation of commercial activities, traffic volume, and traffic mix, in recent years,

WHEREAS, this area is the first interstate exit in New York State and functions as a gateway providing access to many seasonal activities in the Hudson Valley and New England putting drivers unfamiliar with the area into confusing, fast-moving traffic patterns at high-speed creating a dangerous situation,

WHEREAS, local residents, many of them seniors, have repeatedly expressed concerns about safe access to Route 22 from either Peaceful Valley Road or Flint’s Crossing Road given the speed of truck traffic and the illegal parking of trucks on Route 22,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board requests a speed reduction to 45 MPH along this segment of SR 22.
