Resolution 121-2026 to adopt a plan for renovations and upgrade to Stoddard Field Park

At a regular meeting of the Town Board for the Town of Canaan, Columbia County, New York, duly held on the 14th day of September 2026, at the Canaan Town Hall, County Route 5, Canaan, New York, the following Resolution was proposed and seconded:

WHEREAS, a park plan is a planning tool for the enhancement, growth, and development of the town park that provides recreation opportunities and supports the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board identified that a park plan was needed to properly plan for growth and development, identify funding opportunities, protect the environment, and enhance the health, safety, and welfare of the community and residents; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board, hired a planning consultant, Barton and Loguidice, to develop a draft plan for the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, Barton and Loguidice, solicited input from the community via a survey, interactive web page, and public meetings; and

WHEREAS, the proposed plan includes the long-term vision, goals, objectives, and strategies to guide the future growth in the town; and

WHEREAS, if any projects contained in the plan are modified and subject to review by another agency(s), such review shall be completed prior to implementation,

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed the draft plan; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Canaan hereby determines that the Stoddard Field Park Plan and all its Appendices, attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted, and shall be implemented as funding is identified and secured, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board shall cause a full copy of the adopted plan, including all associated documents and maps included in the Appendices be placed and maintained to be accessible on the Town website.
